

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

Purchase Reflective House Numbers (for Mailbox or Entrance Post) to ensure First Responders can locate you! Numbers should be 3-4 inches high. Place on both sides of your mailbox or on a sign post next to your driveway. Numbers should be placed 4 to 7 feet off the ground for headlights to reflect signs at night.



Training:

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

There are challenges associated with Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and 911 Operations when using a cell phone. Cell phones can't find your location like landlines when calling 911.

First Responders can't HELP you if they can't FIND you!
Cell Phones don't ALWAYS work in rural areas.

LAKE GASTON SAFETY

Be prepared for an emergency! Always call 911 first - call from a land line whenever possible. 911 calls from a cell phone may not go to the correct county. If your cell phone call gets misdirected, each county around Lake Gaston has a non-emergency phone number to call: Save these numbers in your cell phone!

ALWAYS CALL 911 FIRST

If you do not get through to the proper county, use these alternate emergency numbers.

LAKE GASTON VISITORS

Are you vacationing here? Do you know the complete address, county, and state where you are staying?

NO?

Ask your rental agent or homeowner to complete a 911 HELP Card, available from the LKG911 Community Task Force, and to post it where all can see. We recommend placing one in your home and one on your dock in case of emergency.

TELL 911 EXACTLY WHERE HELP IS NEEDED WITH what3words



The what3words app has given every 10 ft square in the world a unique combination of 3 words. It's an easy way for people to communicate hard to describe locations such as hiking trails, back roads or spots on the lake.

To give a what3words address in an emergency call 911...then open the what3words app and wait for the blue GPS dot to stabilize. Tap the current location icon. The 3 word address appears on the screen. Read the three words to the 911 operator or tap "share" for additional options.
